Lesson DB: The Miraculous Feeding of Multitudes

Matthew 14.12-21 & 15.29-89 (Mark 6.30-44 & 8.1-9, Luke 9.10-17, John 6.1-14)

- I. A DESOLATE PLACE (14:13)—physical and emotional connotations
 - A. <u>A Place of Physical Barrenness</u>—uninhabited, inhospitable, lacking the resources to nurture life
 - B. A Place of Emotional Retreat—escape and healing
 - **1. Solitude**—to attend to my own soul
 - 2. Rest—from the constant demands of everyday life
 - C. A Place of Spiritual Renewal (Hos 2:14)—a place to meet God and know Him better
 - 1. God's Glory Revealed
 - 2. Fruit from Barren Places

II. A GLORIOUS SAVIOR

- A. <u>His Compassion</u> (Mat 4:1-2)—Jesus cares for the physical and spiritual needs of people.
 - **1. Attentive**—*He notices*.
 - 2. Understanding (Mat 4:1-2; Isa 53:4-5; Heb 4:15)—He has experienced it!
 - **3. Anticipating** (Psalm 103:13-14; 1 Kings 19:7-8)—He provides for the journey ahead.
- B. <u>His Power</u> (Ps 104:14-15)—Jesus of Nazareth wields the power of God the Creator

- III. A MIRACULOUS FEAST (Phil 4:19)
 - A. Jesus multiplied what they brought Him.
 - B. He gave it to His disciples to serve.
 - 1. Jesus touches people with our hands. (Personal Attachment)
 - **2. Jesus gives each of us** a piece **of His ministry.** We can only share what Jesus gives *us* and only *reach* the people that He assigns to us.
 - C. There was more than enough. (2 Cor 9:8)
 - **1. All ate.** Jesus is for everyone
 - 2. Everyone was satisfied. (Isa 55:1-2) Only Jesus can satisfy!
 - **3.** They collected an abundance of <u>leftovers</u>. God is not stingy in His provision.
 - a. Idols (addictions) will leave you hungry.
 - b. Jesus gives enough to satisfy you and to share with a friend!
- IV. <u>SIGNS OF THE MESSIAH</u>—The miracles point us to Jesus Himself, the promised Messiah
 - A. <u>Isaiah's Prophesy</u> (Mat 15:30-31; Isa 35:5-6)—the miraculous healings
 - B. Moses' Prophesy (Deut 18:15-19; Jn 6:14)—the Prophet like Moses
