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PECA Sermon Outline on Exodus 8:16-19, September 8, 2013

Intro:

<u>Main Point of Text:</u> In the third plague, God gets even more personal by pressing His sovereign fingerprint upon the Egyptians.

<u>Sermon Point:</u> *Read the writing on the wall.*

Move 1: God writes His reality into your body.

<u>Vs. 17</u>. God gets even more up-close and personal w/ the Egyptians. Now from the land beneath their feet. This plague crawls into their ears/noses. Their bite causes painful irritation in the skin. Considered an embarrassment: Egyptian priests shaved their heads every three days to avoid carrying them.

Move 2: God writes His reality into your being.

<u>Vs. 16</u>: by raising the dust, God shows up another false god (Ex. 12:12; Num. 33:4): "Set", Egyptian god of the dessert/sandstorms. God reminds of Gen. 3:14, 19. Like dust, He is inescapable. <u>Vss. 18-19</u>: Here is the last time you hear the magicians speak: they confess this is the "finger of God" pressing down upon them with this message: I am God: you're going down. The writing is on the wall, like <u>Daniel 5</u>. Ps. 8:3; Rom. 2:15.

Move 3: How have you received God's message?

God's own finger also wrote down His Moral Law upon two tablets of stone: Ex 31:18; 34:4. Many magicians today still trying to trick you not to read it: <u>2 Tim. 3:1-9</u>. John 8:1-11. Luke 11:20. Heb. 10:7 of Jesus in Ps. 40:8-10. Heb. 10:16 of Christ bringing Jer. 31:33. Seen in Ps. 119:11 and Deut. 6:6-9.
