Subject: Enoch Walked with God

Enoch is mentioned 10 times in the scriptures. He is one of only two men who ever lived on the earth who did not die. That should perk up our attention immediately. Why didn't he die? Because he pleased God and God took him. By a series of questions we will see how deeply Enoch pleased God.

"By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God has translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God." - Hebrews 11:5

1. When did Enoch start to walk with God? Gen. 5:22

- 2. How long did Enoch walk with God?
- 3. How long have you walked with God?

4. Can a person walk with God for 300 years?

5. Did Enoch know his relations back 7 generations to Adam, Seth, Enos, Cainan, Mahalaleel, and Jared?

6. Did he know their wives and probably many of their children?

7. Did he let any of them keep him from walking with God and pleasing Him?

8. Did he have brothers and sisters? Gen. 5:19

9. Did he let his brothers and sisters keep him from pleasing God and walking with Him?

10. Did Enoch have a wife? Gen. 5:21

11. Did Enoch let his wife keep him from walking with God and pleasing Him?

12. Did Enoch have children? Gen. 5:22

13. Did Enoch let any of his children keep him from walking with God and pleasing him?

16. Did Enoch let his oldest son Methuselah keep him from walking with God and pleasing Him?

17. Did Enoch actually see God? Heb. 11:5-6

18. Can a man walk with God and please God even if he doesn't see Him?

19. How is his name spelled in 1 Chronicles 1:3?

20. Was Enoch a preacher? Jude 1:14

21. What was the subject of his preaching? Jude 1:14-15

22. Is Enoch mentioned in the lineage to Christ? Luke 3:37-38

23. Did Adam and Eve live to hear Enoch?

24. Can a man walk with God who has a mother, father, grandmother, grandfather, great uncles and aunts, uncles and aunts, a wife, children, nephews, nieces, grandchildren (Gen. 5:25-26), etc.?

Conclusion:

Surrounded by relatives and family older and younger than him, Enoch did not let one of them keep him from walking with God and pleasing Him. Maybe that is why God took him? He had this testimony that no one meant more to him than God.
