- **1. Everything in the Scripture points to Christ.** (Lk 24:27, 44-45; Jn 5:39; 2 Tim 3:16)
- 2. Jesus is the Only Perfect Man. (Rom 3:10, 23; Heb 4:15)
- **3. Jesus perfectly expresses the mind and heart of God.** (Isa 7:14; Mat 1:23; Jn 1:14, 18; 6:38; 12:49; 14:10)
- 4. Jesus is God's answer to the cries of broken women.

- A. Mary received and helped to fulfill the promise of a Savior given through Eve.
- B. Mary is not the Savior; she *gave birth* to the Savior.
- **III.** MARY, AN EXAMPLE FOR THE CHURCH (Jn 19:25-27)
 - **A. She followed Jesus.** (Jn 19:25)—with the other women at the cross
 - **B. She pointed others to Jesus.** (Jn 2:1-12)—do whatever He says
 - **C. She was committed to the Church.** (Acts 1:14)—presence, prayers, support

CONCLUSIONS: (Mat 10:37; 12:46-50/ Lk 8:19-21; Lk 11:27)

- 1. **Jesus is** (by far) **more important than any other person.**
- 2. Our loyalty and commitment to the Kingdom of God must come before even our love of family.
