The Women Who Anointed Jesus with Perfume

(Lk 7:36-50)

- I. THE BEHAVIOR OF THE WOMAN (37-38)
 - A. The Act was Daring. —risking public scorn and personal rejection
 - 1. To Enter that Social Setting —she was not welcome in polite society
 - **2. To Touch Jesus** —would He pull away in disgust and horror?
 - B. The Gift was Extravagant. —the worth of Jesus, she held nothing back
 - C. The Delivery was Sincere.
 - **1.** <u>Emotional</u> (38; Ps 62:8)—vulnerability, pouring out her soul in tears
 - **2.** <u>Physical</u> (Ps 63:1; Jam 2:17, 26)—*sensuous* (perceived by the physical senses) Her actions gave powerful witness to her faith.
 - D. The Interaction was Personal. —emotional intimacy, spiritual connection
- **II.** THE REACTION OF A PHARISEE (39)
 - A. <u>Unbelieving</u> —Jesus is not a prophet.
 - B. $\underline{\text{Judgmental}}$ This woman is not worthy of attention or kindness.
 - **1.** Misrepresenting the Character of God (Ps 103:8; Ex 34:6; Joe. 2:13; Jonah 4:2)

- **2.** <u>Usurping the Position of God</u> (Jn 5:22; Act 10:42; Rom 14:10; 1 Cor 4:5; 2 Tim 4:1; 1 Pet 4:5)
- **3.** <u>Blind to our own condition</u>.(Mat 15:3; Lk 6:37; Rom 2:23) *self-righteous*.
- C. Coldhearted (44, 47)—little love
- III. THE RESPONSE OF JESUS (40-50)—
 - A. Protective (Num 35:13; Rom 10:11)—speaks up to defend the woman
 - B. <u>Humanizing</u> (44; Gen 16:3; Ps 142:4; Jn 10:3;)—*recognizing her personhood and dignity*
 - **C.** Accepting (Ps 25:18; 51:6, 15-17; Isa 38:17; Hos 14:2; Mat 11:28; Lk 5:32; Jn 6:37; Heb 4:15-16; 1 Jn 1:9)— *Not EXCUSING sin but FORGIVING it*
- IV. THE QUESTION OF WORTH
 - A. <u>Jesus is worthy</u>. (2 Sam 23:15-17; Ps 63:3; 84:10)—of utmost love and devotion
 - B. <u>Jesus makes us worthy</u>. (Isa43:1; 44:2; Jer 31:3; 2 Cor 1:21)—the price He paid proves the value He places upon us.
 - C. <u>Jesus wants our love</u>. (Ps 45:11; Song 2:14 & 7:5)—*He is in love with us*.
