## The Last Supper

Matthew 26:17-30

- I. THE CELEBRATION OF PASSOVER (17-19; Ex 12)—commemoration of the Exodus
  - A. The Bondage (1 Jn 5:19; Jn 8:34)—Egypt, the Oppression of Satan and Slavery of Sin
  - **B.** The Deliverer (Heb 3:3-6, 8:6)—Jesus, the Savior greater than Moses
    - 1. The Prophet of God (Dt 18:15-19; Act 3:22-23)—spoke for God, performed miracles
    - **2.** The <u>Mediator</u> of the Covenant (1 Tim 2:5; Heb 8:6, 9:15; 12:18-24)—received the Law and instituted God's Covenant with the nation of Israel
    - **3.** An <u>Intercessor</u> for the People (Ex 32:9-14; 30-32; Dt 9:25; Isa 53:12; Heb 7:25)— pleaded for God's mercy when they broke covenant
  - C. The Lamb (Isa 53; 1 Cor 5:7)—Jesus, the Perfect Sacrifice
    - 1. The <u>Sacrifice</u> of a Substitute (Jn 1:29; 1 Jn 2:2; Heb 7:27)—without defect
    - 2. The <u>Sight</u> of Blood (Ex 12:13)—identifies and protects the redeemed
      - **a.** The Cost of Redemption (Gen 2:17; Rom 6:23; Heb 9:22; 1 Pet 1:18-19)
      - **b.** The Covering of Sin (Ex 12:23; Isa 40:1-5, 9)—paid in full
    - **3.** The Meal of Fellowship (Ex 24:8-11; Rev 3:20)—fed, nourished and sustained
- II. THE MAKING OF A COVENANT—agreement between God and His people
  - A. The Old Covenant (Ex 24:3-11)—Keep God's Law and He will be your God
    - 1. Made with the Nation of Israel (set apart from the world as holy, OT Church)
    - 2. Mediated by Moses
    - **3. Instituted by the Sacrifice of Oxen** (Ex 24:3-8)—the blood of the covenant
    - 4. Required obedience to the <u>Law</u> (Ex 24:7)
      - a. Written on Stone (Ex 31:18)—the Ten Commandments
      - b. Broken by Israel (Ex 32:1-8 19)—Golden Calf, etc...
    - 5. Resulted in Covenant Curses

- B. The New Covenant (Jeremiah 31:31-34)—Come to God through Jesus
  - **1. Made with the Church** (called out of the world from every nation)
  - **2. Mediated by Jesus** (Heb 9:15)
  - 3. Instituted by the Sacrifice of Jesus (28)—"the new covenant in my blood"
  - 4. Fulfilled the requirements of the Law ()
    - a. Kept perfectly by Jesus
    - b. Written on our Hearts

## 5. Resulted in Covenant Blessings:

- a. Our sin is counted as His; He takes our punishment.
- b. His obedience is counted as ours; He gives us His blessing.

## III. THE INSTITUTION OF COMMUNION

- **A.** <u>The Elements</u> (26-27)—common, everyday, essential food items
  - **1. The (Unleavened) Bread**—the body of Jesus, broken for us
  - 2. The Cup (of Wine)—the blood of Jesus, shed for the forgiveness of our sins
- **B.** <u>The Mystery</u>—What happens when we take Communion?
  - **1. Literal Physical Presence, Sacrament**—transubstantiation, grace dispensed
  - 2. Actual Spiritual Presence, Sacrament—grace received by faith
  - 3. Metaphorical, Symbolic Commemoration—sacred memorial, object lesson

## C. The Meaning

- **1.** The Sacrificial Atonement of Christ (1 Cor 1:23-26)—Jesus died in my place.
- **2.** Our Unity with Christ—His life is my life; He feeds, fills, satisfies me with Himself.
- 3. Our Membership in the Church—unity and fellowship in the family of God
