## Mary of Bethany

(Lk 10:38-42; Jn 11:1-45; 12:1-8)

## I. MARY'S CHOICE (Lk 10:38-42)—non-traditional role of disciple

- A. <u>Different Personalities</u> *There is not one, single Christian personality.*
- B. Different Ministries (Rom 12:3-6; 1 Cor 12:4-6)
  - 1. God created <u>individuals</u>.
  - 2. God has <u>designed</u> each person for her particular <u>calling</u>.
- II. MARY'S TEARS (John 11:28-37)
  - **A.** Jesus is not afraid of (a woman's) emotions. He understands and empathizes.
  - B. Jesus responds to (a woman's) tears. (Ps 107:6, 13, 19, 28)
    - 1. Jesus <u>understands</u> tears. (Rom 8:26; Psalm 56:8)
    - 2. Jesus empathizes with tears. (Ex 2:23-25; Isa 63:9)
    - 3. Jesus weeps with those who weep. (Jn 11:35; Rom 12:15)
- III. MARY'S GIFT (Jn 12:1-8)—different from Martha's
  - A. <u>Costly</u>—worth a year's wages, the best thing she had
  - B. <u>Public</u> (Mat 10:32)—honored and adored Him before others

- C. <u>Personal</u>—her unique gift to Jesus
  - 1. What She Had
    - a. Anointed His feet with Perfume-humility
    - **b.** Wiped His feet with her Hair—intimate, romantic, scandalous
  - 2. What She Understood of Jesus (Jn 12:7)
    - a. Insightful
    - b. Supportive
    - c. Prophetic
- D. <u>Praiseworthy</u> (Jn 12:7-8)—Jesus defends and praises Mary's gift
  - 1. Jesus understands, accepts, and fulfills the romance in a woman's heart.
  - 2. Jesus is worthy of the greatest love, the highest honor, and the utmost devotion of which a woman is capable.
  - 3. Jesus desires and welcomes our love poured out to Him in worship.
