Lesson 23: Lord of the Harvest

Matthew 9:35-10:15; Ezekiel 34

- **THE SCATTERED FLOCK** (9:35-36; Num 27:16-17) Ultimately the prayer of Moses and the promise to David finds fulfillment in Jesus Christ.
 - A. The Compassionate Heart (36)—deeply moved with pity
 - **B.** The Distressed Sheep (Jer 50:6; Ezk 34)
 - **1. Harassed** They were weary, neglected, burdened and abused by those who misrepresented God and falsely mishandled His Law.
 - **2. Helpless** Sheep cannot protect or provide for themselves
 - **3.** Without a Shepherd Jesus does not despise the sheep; He longs to gather them.
 - C. The Greater David (9:27; Ps 78:70-72; Isa 40:11; Ezk 34:23-24)—the "Son of David"
 - 1. Israel's King—the right to rule
 - 2. Israel's Shepherd—rules the nation like a shepherd tends his flock of sheep
- **II.** A Great Harvest (9:37-38; Isa 5:1-2; Mat 3:8)—
 - A. <u>Ingathering of Souls</u> (Rev 14:14-19)—many saved before the Final Judgment
 - B. Need for Harvesters (Rom 10:13-15)
 - 1. Why are workers needed? (Rom 10:13-15) To take the Gospel to the world
 - a. The <u>Season</u> of Harvest (Mat 24:14; Heb 3:7-8)—until Jesus returns
 - b. The Abundance of Harvest (Rev 7:9-10)—a great international multitude
 - 2. How should we respond to the need? (38) Pray
 - **C.** Lord of the Harvest The Son of Man in Daniel and Revelation
 - 1. <u>His Authority</u>—Those who work for Jesus must be invested with His authority.
 - 2. His Workers (Acts 13:2)—He chooses and sends.
 - **3. His Field**—We are not in competition with other Christian ministries!

III. The Apostles' Training (10:1-10)—A major part of Jesus' ministry was training Apostles.

A. Authority

- **1.** Is **Real** Spiritual authority is not a human management position.
- **2.** Is **Needed** We do not have the power to stand against Satan on our own.
- **3. Is Given**—Satan must give way before those who bear the authority of Christ.

B. Commission

- **1. To the Lost Sheep of Israel** (Rom 1:16 & 2:9-10;)—first to Jews, then to Gentiles
- 2. To Preach the Kingdom of Heaven—It is near (repent).
- **3. To Do Miracles of Mercy**—Care for sick, dying, outcast, rescue souls from Satan.

C. Support

- **1. No <u>Charge</u>** (8b)—The Gospel is free!
- 2. No Supplies (9)—Short term, training mission; build faith and experience of Apostles.
 - a. This is God's work. It does not depend upon your planning and resources.
 - **b.** The Lord will provide. (Mat 6:33) All you need while you are doing His business.
 - **c.** Those who are served should support. (10b) The workman is worthy of his hire.

IV. MESSENGERS OF PEACE (10:11-15)

- A. Seeking a Worthy Person—God has already prepared somebody where you are going.
- **B.** <u>Blessing a Home</u>—traditional Jewish greeting is "Shalom" (peace); not mere formality
 - **1.** The <u>Resting</u> of Peace—God will bless the home that welcomes Christ's messenger.
 - **2.** The <u>Return</u> of Peace—Their rejection does not need to ruin your peace; you keep it.

C. Handling Rejection (10:14-15)

- **1. Move On** (Mat 7:6)—Practice Christ's teaching on discernment.
- 2. Shake the Dust from Your Feet—Sign (duly noted) and warning,
- 3. Wait for the Judgment of God
 - a. It is not your place to punish.
 - b. God will judge and punish fairly.
