Jn 19:25; 20:1-18

(Mat 27:56, 61; 28:1-11; Mk 15:40, 47; 16:1, 9; Lk 8:2, 3; 24:1-12)

- I. Who Is Mary Magdalene?
 - A. <u>The Confusion</u>—a lot of women named Mary and men with more than one name
 - B. <u>The Gospels</u>—Matthew, Mark, Luke and John
 - 1. One of Many Women Who Followed Jesus (Mat 27:56; Mk 15:40-41; Lk 8:1-3)
 - a. <u>Benefactress</u>—financially supported the ministry of Jesus and His disciples
 - b. <u>Devoted Follower</u>—traveled with Jesus and His disciples as part of His ministry support team
 - **2.** A <u>Recipient</u> of Jesus' Healing/Exorcism (Mk 16:9 ; Lk 8:2) delivered from seven demons
 - 3. The First Witness of Jesus' Resurrection (Mk 16:9)

II. What does she show us of JESUS?

- A. <u>The Reality of His Resurrection</u> (Isa 61:2-3) First to find, see, hear touch Jesus after the Resurrection
- B. <u>His Power to Save and Heal</u> (Jn 10:10; 1 Jn 3:8; Heb 2:14) Jesus freed her from the bondage of seven demons, healed her, and transformed her life.
- C. The Compelling Nature of His Person

Faith is not merely intellectual excitement over an idea or commitment to Jesus' teaching; she *loves Jesus*.

D. The Worth of His Kingdom

- 1. <u>My Life</u> (1 Cor 6:19b-20; Gal 2:20; Phil 1:21) Her life, focus, time, service, purpose
- 2. <u>My Fortune</u> (Mat 6:19-21, 24, 33; Song 8:7) Financially fund the spread of His kingdom
- **3.** <u>My Sacred Honor</u> (Mat 10:32-33; Jn 15:18-20) Her lot, her *identity* and *her reputation*
