The Women Who Followed Jesus

Luke 8:1-3; 23:49; 55-56; 24:1-10 (Mat 27:55-56; Mk 15:40; Jn 19:25)

- I. WOMEN ARE INDIVIDUALS. seen in the various accounts of Gospel women
 - A. <u>Different Personalities</u> (Mary and Martha)—no one ideal personality for Christian women
 - B. <u>Different Ministries</u> (Rom 12:4-8)—utilizing different gifts; financial support, traveling ministry team, hospitality, cooking, discipleship, anointing, etc...
 - C. <u>Different Social Situations</u>
 - 1. <u>Marital Status</u> (Mat 22:30; Lk 10:41-42; 11:27-28)—relationship with Jesus is forever and takes priority, even over marriage
 - 2. <u>Economic Circumstances</u>—rich and poor; from the wife of Herod's household manager to the widow offering her two pennies in the temple
 - 3. <u>Moral Backgrounds</u>—respectable to notorious sinners; Jesus' mother and Mary Magdalene are together at the cross of Jesus
- WOMEN ARE REDEEMED. (Lk 19:10; Mat 9:12; Ruth 3:9; 4:14) healed of demons and diseases, forgiven, restored, valued
 - A. Jesus is our Kinsman Redeemer.
 - B. Jesus restores freedom and creation glory to women.

- III. WOMEN ARE DISCIPLES. valued souls and intellects
 - A. Jesus discusses theology with the Woman at the Well. (Jn 4: 7-26)
 - B. <u>Jesus defends</u> the choice of <u>Mary of Bethany</u> to sit at His feet. (Lk 10:42)
 - C. <u>Angels at the Tomb remind</u> the women of Jesus' teaching. (Lk 24:6-8, Mt 16:21; Mk 8:27-31; Lk 9:18-22).
- IV. WOMEN ARE WITNESSES. dismissed in their culture but equal in the church
 - A. The Woman at the Well is the Messiah's witness to her town. (Jn 4)
 - B. The Women at the Tomb are the first witnesses of Jesus' resurrection. (Mat 28:8-10; Mk 16:9; Lk 24:9-10; Jn 20:1-2, 10-18)
- V. WOMEN ARE MESSENGERS. (Mat 28:7, 10; Mk 16:10; Jn 20:17-18) Sent by Jesus with instructions for the men—placing them in company of angels and prophets!
- VI. WOMEN ARE FRIENDS. (Lk 20:10-16; Jn 11:5)
 - A. Jesus <u>heals and restores</u> everything ruined by the Fall. Male-female relationship
 - B. Jesus restores equal dignity to women.
 - 1. As Humans (Gen 1:27)—equal image-bearers of God
 - 2. As Christians (Joel 2:28-29/Acts 2:17-18; Gal 3:26-29)—equal heirs with sons
