The Darkest Day: The Death and Burial of Christ

Matthew 27:50-66

- I. <u>THE MOMENTOUS SIGNS</u>—unmistakable supernatural omens in the natural world
 - **A.** <u>DARKNESS</u> (Jeremiah 4:23, 28; Amos 8:9)—full solar eclipse from noon to 3:00 PM while Jesus was on the cross.
 - B. <u>EARTHQUAKE</u> (Jer 4:24; Amos 8:8)—when Jesus died, the earth shook and rocks split
 - **C. TEMPLE CURTAIN TORN** (Heb 9:8, 12, 24, 25; Heb 10:11-14)—
 - 1. An Act of God ()—It was torn from top to bottom
 - 2. The Departure of God's Presence (Ezek 9:3, 10:4-18)—preparation for judgment
 - 3. The Passing of the Old Order (Heb 9:1-10; 10:19-22)—Christ has fulfilled it all
 - **a. The Temple Building** (2 Sam 7:12-13; Mat 1:23; Mat 26:61; Jn 1:14; Col 1:15-19)—Jesus is the True Temple of God, God in human flesh
 - **b.** The Sacrifices for Sin (Jn 1:29; Heb 9:25-26, 10:10)—Jesus was the ultimate Sacrifice for sin.
 - **c.** The Priesthood of Aaron (Heb 10:11-14, 21)—Jesus is the ultimate Great High Priest over the house of God.
 - **4.** The Open Access to God ()—unveiled intimacy; full atonement completed
 - **D.** <u>OPENED TOMBS</u> (Dan 12:1-2)—saints resurrected; Great Resurrection to come
- **II.** THE LOUD CRIES (46-50; Heb 5:7)—
 - A. The Cry of Abandonment (Ps 22; Heb 12:2)
 - 1. The Reality of Feeling (Ps 22:1)—honest, anguished, visceral human experience
 - 2. The Context of Faith—the whole of Psalm 22
 - B. The Cry of Completion (Lk 23:46; Jn 19:30)—"It is finished!"

- III. THE COMPANY OF WOMEN (55, 56, 61)—Jesus had women patrons, friends, disciples
 - **A. There were many.** (Mk 15:40-41; Jn 19:25)
 - B. They were notably <u>present</u>.
 - C. They <u>followed</u> Jesus. (Jn 4:27; Lk 8:2-3, 10:39-42)—traveled with Him and the Apostles
 - **D. They ministered to Him.** (Lk 8:3b)—actively and financially involved in the ministry
- IV. THE QUIET FRIEND (57-60; Isa 53:9)—Joseph of Arimathea
 - A. Jesus has many friends that we don't know about. (1 King 19:18; Jn 21:25)
 - **B. Everyone has** a **gift and a role.** (1 Cor 12:4-6) Joseph's moment to shine; he did what he could.
- V. THE SECURE BURIAL (62-66)
 - A. The Paranoia of Unbelief (63)—Ironic that His enemies remember and disciples forget!
 - B. The Gratuitous Guard (65-66)—insult and obstacle become indisputable proof
 - 1. The Weight of the Stone—the heavy force of nature (gravity and death)
 - **2. The Posting of** Soldiers—the intimidating force of human strength and weapons
 - **3. The Placing of a** Seal—the official human authority
