## **Active Waiting**

The List of 12 Apostle's is only 11. v 13

**They Prayed while they Waited. v 14** 1) Devoted themselves to prayer. (Luke 24:50-53)

> 2) They prayed with one accord, with one mind. When we are not in one accord. The focus is the mission.

AT Pierson, "There has never been a revival in any country that has not begun in united prayer."

# Something is Missing (Peter's proposal) v 15-26

Peter was meditating on the imprecatory Psalms.

He quotes from Psalm 69:25, and Psalm 109:8.

These psalms apply to Judas as an enemy of God and his people.

Replacement was necessary. <u>Another must take his office</u>. Why? 12 tribes, 12 thrones, etc. (Luke 22:28-30; Matthew 19:28)

Why is 120 disciples mentioned?

Lukes comment v 18-19

Did Judas hang himself? (Matthew) Do did he fall headlong? (Luke)
