## I. MAKING SENSE OF OUR STORIES

- A. Genre—the type of literature significantly influences how you interpret it.
  - 1. The Bible is made up of works in different genres.
  - 2. History tells us the way things <u>really happened</u>, not the way things <u>should</u> be.
  - 3. Scripture confronts us with the reality of the human condition.
- B. Context—how does the part we are seeing fit into the whole?
  - 1. Individual stories play a part in the larger story of Redemptive History.
  - 2. The questions raised by these stories are one side of a dialogue.
- II. <u>UNDERSTANDING THE PROBLEM</u> (Gen 3:16)—Creation marred by the Fall
  - **A.** <u>Creation was perfect</u>. (Gen 1:1, 31) God created everything, and it was *all good*.
  - **B.** The Fall was catastrophic. (Gen 3)— sin and death enter the world
    - 1. The world now is not the way that God created it to be.
    - 2. We are born broken and predisposed to self-destruct.
    - 3. We need a savior who is able to forgive and to change us.

- C. <u>The Curse Became Reality</u>. (Gen 3:15-19)
  - **1. The Pain of Bearing Children**—where all our gynecology problems began.
  - 2. The Disruption of Male-Female Relationship
    - **a.** Idolatrous and blasphemous desire of the woman
    - **b.** Domination, abuse, and oppression of women (domestic and societal)
- III. LOOKING FOR THE ANSWER (Gen 3:15; Isa 9:6-7)—Jesus is God's Answer
  - **A.** <u>Jesus Is the Savior of Eve</u>. (1 Cor 15:21-22; Rom 5:12, 14-19)—fully human
    - **1.** The <u>Representative</u> of Humanity—He came to pass the test Adam failed.
    - **2.** The <u>Model</u> of Manhood—Jesus perfectly demonstrates how a man of God should think, feel and act.
  - **B.** Jesus is the Son of God. (Mat 14:33 & 16:16; Mk 3:11)—fully God
    - 1. The <u>Representative</u> of God (Dan 7:13-14; Rev 5)—authority to act for God
    - 2. The <u>Image</u> of God (Jn 14:7, 9, Col 1:15)—Who God is, what He is like
    - **3.** The <u>Expositor</u> of God (Jn 1:1-3, 18)—the one who explains God *All Scripture must be understood in relation to Jesus.*
  - C. <u>Jesus is the Answer of God</u> to the cries of broken women.
